Order,

I would now like to give a statement in my capacity as Minister of Foreign Affairs. Please be aware that this report is classified and that sharing it outside of this House is a criminal offence.

Allegations have recently come forward of inappropriate conduct towards minors by ██████████, the President of ██████████. ██████████ has been expelled from the Grand Unified Micronational and ██████████ has been banned from MicroWiki.

Some of you may be aware that ██████████ was present at the GUM summit that I hosted at the UoB Guild of Students last June. That evening, he and I went to the Bristol Pear along with Lady Peace and the Prime Minister of Lundenwic Mr. Michael Lewis, where ██████████ openly spoke of his sexual relations with a number of prominent micronationalists in the period 2011-13. What ██████████ neglected to mention was that some of these micronationalists were underage. What was even more concerning was that a number of members of the MicroWiki "old guard" were aware of ██████████' past transgressions. Apparently, ██████████ was ostracised from the micronational community at the time, but seems to have been allowed to return with the site administration believing his assertion that he was a reformed man ██████████.

I was not made aware of ██████████' past transgressions by ██████████, who also attended the summit last summer and who was aware. ██████████ has apologised to me for not making me aware, saying that he believed that I already knew, and that he was himself keeping an eye on ██████████. Unfortunately shortly after the summit, ██████████ began inappropriately messaging a member of the ██████████ delegation to the summit, all of whom were underage. It should be noted that ██████████ is aged ██████████. Naturally this involves me in a major safeguarding failure as these minors were under my duty of care at this summit.

██████████ largely treated ██████████' messages as banter until several weeks ago, when they learned of ██████████' past via a member of the old guard, which put them in a new context. They then alerted the Chair of the GUM, Mr. Thomas Bainbridge, who was also unaware. A couple of other recent victims also came forward. There ensued a chaotic session of the Quorum of Delegates during which many rumours were leaked to the micronational press. The victims decided not to go to the macro authorities and the GUM was unable to share the evidence they provided, allowing ██████████ to claim on social media that he was being defamed. ██████████ has been able to rally large swathes of the Twitter community and some of the prominent Facebook nations (such as ██████████ where he was formerly foreign minister) to his side, and many on MicroWiki, whilst believing ██████████' guilt, believe that the GUM, particularly Mr. Bainbridge, responded poorly.

At this present time, although ██████████, Adammia continues to support the GUM and I have seen compelling evidence which, whilst not implicating ██████████ in anything *technically* illegal, certainly proves that he is not as reformed as he claimed. I intend to issue an Imperial Decree in the near future rescinding diplomatic recognition of ██████████.

Members should be aware that, as a result of taking this stance, Adammia's standing amongst certain micronational communities, particularly those on Twitter and Facebook, is likely to be damaged, but I do believe that it is morally the right position to take. TOPICAL DEBATE – Response to the coronavirus pandemic

Order,

I am now calling a general debate on the matter of the coronavirus situation. Members will be aware of the state of emergency that we have declared. I can confirm at this time that there are still zero known cases of coronavirus in the Empire.

The other place (that is to say, the Ruling Council) convened last week where I discussed the status of the provinces with their representatives. The population of South Adammia has dropped from eight to one, with the Prime Minister being the only person remaining there. I was evacuated to County Maternia about a month ago by His Imperial Highness the Emperor Father. Most other residents of the South have also returned home to their families.

At some point I intend to dissolve Corellia, move Serkatia to Lord Helliker's residence in Poole and downgrade it to a colony, and reduce Metchlia to only the county of Elgaria. I will be also be discussing with some of the first and second year students in Birmingham who may be interested in setting up territories there in the next academic year, although this is obviously touch-and-go at this stage. These changes will probably happen at some point over the summer, before the next general election.
